BEFORE THE GAME:

Remove all Pay cards from the deck.
 Shuffle and deal two cards to each player.

- Deal six cards to the Street.
- With each card, adjust the Market.
- Determine the starting player.
- Give players £10, £11, £12, etc.

AFTER ONE ROUND:

Shuffle the Pay cards into the deck.
 Play will continue until eight Pay cards have been revealed.

- 1: All of your Loans pay.
- 2: You may buy and sell Loans.
- 3: You may influence the Market.
- 4: If there are six Loans in the Street, draw one of them into your hand.

 If one Pay card is drawn, pay Loans.
 (If this was the 8th Pay, the game ends.)
 Subsequent Pay cards are recycled.

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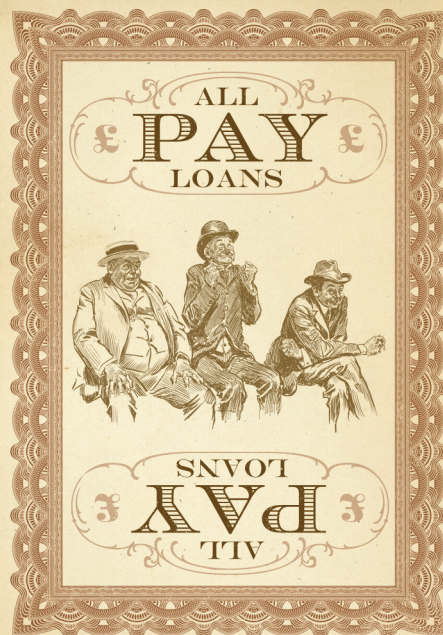
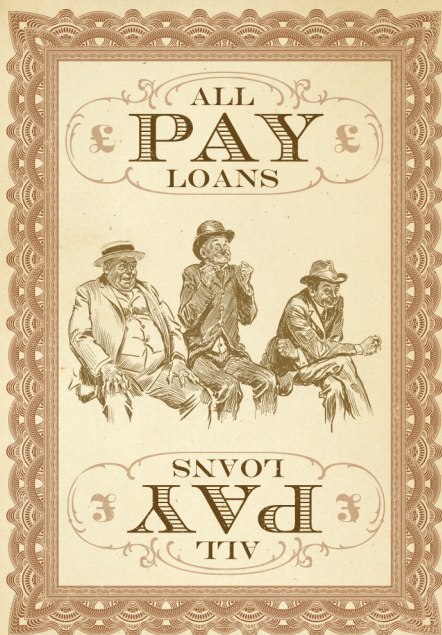
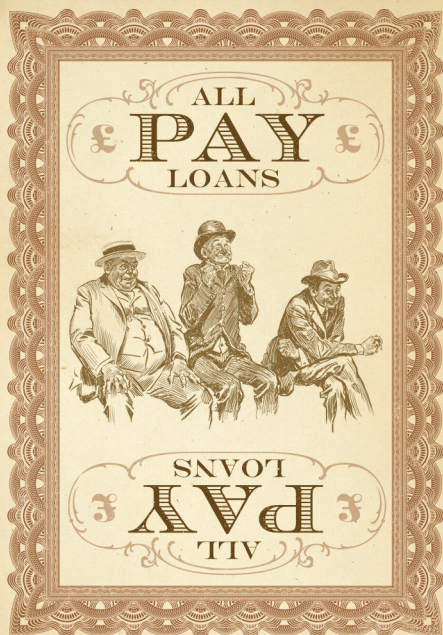
